The Cold Storage Manager facilitates, organizes, and manages the Princeton Curling Rink for the purpose of cold storage for tree seedlings used in reforestation. The Cold Storage Manager works closely with and reports to the A+G Reforestation Project Manager and representatives of Weyerhaeuser.

The Princeton Curling Rink is used as a cold storage facility for tree seedlings used for reforestation. Trees are delivered to the Princeton Curling rink in 50' reefer trucks from a central cold storage facility. These trees need to be unloaded from the reefer truck onto pallets/tables in the Princeton Curling Rink, where they are stored for a maximum of 14 days. Tree planting companies take seedlings from the curling rink on a daily basis.

WHERE & WHEN:

Princeton, BC at the Princeton Curling Club.

Timing: Mid April to Early July (estimated).

Days of week: This role operates on irregular daytime hours, typically between 10-15 hours per week.

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR
